**Spiritual Growth and Liturgy Committee
Meeting Minutes
February 22, 2007**

A. Call to Order/Prayer

Bob Hauser called the meeting to order in the Music Room at approximately 7pm and led the committee in the Litany of St. Peter, Prince of the Apostles.

B. Review and Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the January 25 meeting were distributed and one correction was made. Cyndi Volcko's name had been misspelled in Item C.

C. Gathering Space Table

First cost estimates for the table were received from Ben and Jan Svec. The committee determined it's not feasible to continue the project at this time, and will revisit the project at a later date.

D. Our Lady of Guadalupe Painting

Deacon John McCully has mentioned that the Hispanic ministry would like a permanent placement for the Our Lady of Guadalupe painting in the Chapel. Fr. Nienhaus suggested that one chair be removed from the altar area and that the painting be placed on an easel in the northeast corner of the Chapel.

E. Distribution of the Blood of Christ

Bob Hauser reported that within the last couple of weeks there have been requests for more wine to be consecrated, since those in the back of the Church rarely get to partake of both species. Discussion followed and three main points were mentioned:

1. It is better to error on the more conservative side when consecrating wine.
2. There is no room at the altar to add more cup ministers.
3. We don't want to overfill the cups or refill the cups during the distribution of Communion because of the increased risk of spilling the Precious Blood of Christ.

F. Easter Sunday - An additional Mass at 7:00 am has been added that weekend.

G. Perpetual Adoration

Three new adorers were added after the Ministry Fair.

Planning for the Corpus Christi procession is shaping up.

This year's procession will end at Inis Grove Park.

We are looking into the possibility of St. Cecilia families hosting prayer stations along the route.

Police have been contacted to help us cross the busiest intersections.

H. Eucharistic Congress

Cyndi has contacted Sail Aweigh Travel regarding potential packages to the next Eucharistic Congress in Quebec. At this time, Sail Aweigh suggested it may be cheaper to go by air. The committee discussed the advantages of possibly having our own bus to get around to events.

I. Outdoor Banners

The new Lenten Banners have arrived. Bob hung three of banners, but noted a problem existed with many of the banner poles. Bill Haas volunteered to try to get the banners up before the weekend.

J. Other Issues

Jacque Zbracki mentioned that she met a couple of new mothers that would appreciate a place of privacy during Liturgies, and also recommended that a rocking chair might be purchased for mothers in the Gathering Space. Committee members suggested contacting Carolyn Konechne, President of the Saint Cecilia Council of Catholic Women, to see if the circles could help provide one or more rocking chairs for this area. Fr. Nienhaus mentioned that the new Ushers room could be utilized by mothers for privacy.

K. Adjournment – The meeting was adjourned with prayer at approximately 8 pm.
